1. BEFORE YOU WASH:

- --Make sure your washer and dryer are in good working order with no rough areas that might snag fabric
- -- Lights and darks should be separated
- -- Wash all polyester separate from cotton and poly/cotton fabrics.
- -- Never overload the machine.

2. WASHING:

- --Water temperature should not exceed 140 degrees
- --Use a gradual cool-down or split rinse
- -- Use bleach on white only; it can cause colors on polyester to fade or to change color shade
- --Choose laundry products with the correct alkalinity.
- -- Avoid fabric softeners.

3. EXTRACTION:

--Keep extraction time short (30-60 seconds) to minimize wrinkles.

4. DRYING:

- -- Do not overload dryer.
- -- Temperature should not exceed 140 degrees
- --Don't over-dry, only 10-20 minutes
- -- To avoid wrinkles, remove polyester fabric while still slightly damp and warm. Pat flat and fold promptly.

GENERAL TABLE LINEN WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

- Make sure your washer and dryer are in good working order with no rough areas that might snag fabric.
- All linens should be free of excess food. Shake to remove foreign debris.
- Stains should be pre-treated with products similar to Shout®, Zout®, OxiClean®, or Lestoil®. Follow all manufacturer's instructions. Test stain remover on hidden area of linens before use.
- Wash dark colors separately.
- Wash like fibers together. Do not mix Polyester with Poly/Cotton Blends, etc.
- Do not overload washer or dryer.
- Gradually cool linens in dryer to avoid temperature shock and excessive wrinkling.
- Fold immediately after taking out of dryer.
- If using a mangle (roller/rotary iron) put linens in slightly damp and use a temperature setting of 250°. Be sure to feed linens in straight on fabric grain to avoid shape distortion.
